

# Increase Medicaid In-home Nursing Rates to Protect Access to Care

## Who receives care from the Medicaid Private Duty Nursing (PDN) program?

- A small group of medically fragile, acutely ill North Carolinians who require physician ordered, one-on-one nursing care to stay safely at home
- In 2020, approximately 1,804 individuals state-wide, of which half are children
- Recipients coping with a traumatic brain injury, or are ventilator and tracheostomy dependent requiring hands-on nursing interventions

## Annual nursing costs by setting:

In-home nursing saves the State \$78,000 – \$193,000 per year, per recipient.

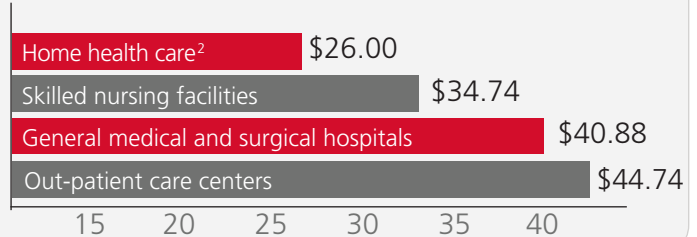

## Benefits of increasing the Medicaid PDN rate for in-home nursing

- Clinically complex, medically fragile children and adults can stay in their homes and out of higher-cost settings
- Helps reduce costly hospital re-admissions, ER visits, and secondary infections
- Creates nursing jobs in the community and allows families to continue to work while being a cost-savings to the state
- Lower cost, better outcomes, patient preferred

## Home care nurses are paid less than their counterparts<sup>1</sup>

Due to low Medicaid reimbursement rates, home care agencies can't compete with other health care providers for qualified nurses.



Invest **\$30.9M** in PDN = Keeping families together by increasing the Medicaid PDN rate by \$20 an hour



## Medicaid Nursing Reimbursement Rates Don't Match Other Government Payers.

NC Veterans Affairs reimburses \$94-\$124 for the same services.
