## Proposal 1: Appropriate \$200 Million in <u>non-wage</u> for healthcare at home capacity

#### \$80 Million Fund for CHHA & Hospices

in Year 1 to meet community need for high-cost/high-need, remote, underserved, and special care populations across all regions of NYS by funding for <u>non-wage</u> purposes including, but not limited to:

• recruitment & retention, technology & other tools to optimally operate agency & deliver care, support for population/need-specific training

#### \$120 Million Fund for LHCSAs

to support improvements in personal care service access, delivery & quality by strengthening care management, operational capacity & <u>non-wage</u> personnel investments

### Proposal 2: Companion home healthcare & hospice critical Art. VII measures

- Ensure previous budget's home care aide wage increase funding & transparent State-plan-provider-aide pathway
- **Reject proposed MLTC contracting provisions with LHCSAs & FIs** and **repeal the LHCSA RFO**, an unimplemented pre-pandemic budget initiative to cut home care
- Allocate funds to support sustainable solutions to end healthcare workforce crisis, with designated appropriation for community healthcare, and home care & hospice specifically for which HCA has recommendations

Minimum Wage	Modify	Eliminate provision to pause wage increases for home care aides; <b>Reject</b> minimum wage index to COLA <u>unless</u> funding is guaranteed across all payers; <b>ensure previous budget's promised funding</b> for aide increase & create transparent payment pathway as outlined in <b>Proposal 2</b>
CDPAP/FI Provisions	<b>Oppose</b> (pending further assessment)	<b>Clarify intention &amp; possibly eliminate:</b> FI solicitation provision, wage parity exemption & supplemental premium assistance for CDPAP PAs; <b>eliminate</b> MLTC contracting provision



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
